Hong Kong (SAR), China: Airport Passager Security Charge - 15-

Please be informed that according to IATA Ticket Tax Box Service, The Hong Kong Airport Passenger Security Charge, currently collected as a Q surcharge, will be assigned the tax code I5 for collection in the Ticket Tax Box.

Hong Kong (SAR), China – HK – Name of TFC: Airport Passenger Security Charge – code- I5

1/ Country Name: Hong Kong (SAR), China ISO Code: HK

2/ Name of Tax / Charge / Fee: Airport Passenger Security Charge

3/ Ticket Code: I5

4/ Effective date: Effective for tickets issued on / after 01 May 2017 and for travel on / after 01 May 2017.

5/ Purpose: To recover the incremental costs incurred from additional security measures

6/ Amounts:

Hong Kong International (HKG):

International Departures: HKD45

7/ The Tax is to be collected at the point of sale and shown separately on the ticket by code I5.

8/ The lifting airline is responsible for remittance.

9/ This Tax is: Interlineable.

10/ Exemptions:

- Transit same plane through transit

11/ Special Notes:

On the date the new I5 becomes effective, the <u>non-ticketable</u> taxes, fee and charge called "Passenger Security Charge" is expired.
