关于塞班入境旅客 I-736/I-94 表格 相关信息通知

各境内外一线销售单位：

现对持有俄罗斯、中国护照享有签证豁免计划、E2C 签证和有条件豁免的旅客入境塞班时，所携带文件要求如下：

自 2018 年 1 月 16 日起，入境塞班旅客将不再使用 I-94 表格。只需在旅客到达塞班前，网上填写完成 I-736 表格，并将本人或家庭成员的 I-736 表格打印签字后随身携带。在入境塞班时，需将纸质版本的 I-736 表格、酒店住宿证明和机票行程单提交至美国海关及边境保护局（USCBP）官员。

重要提示：I-736 表格仅在表格签署的 7 天之内有效。

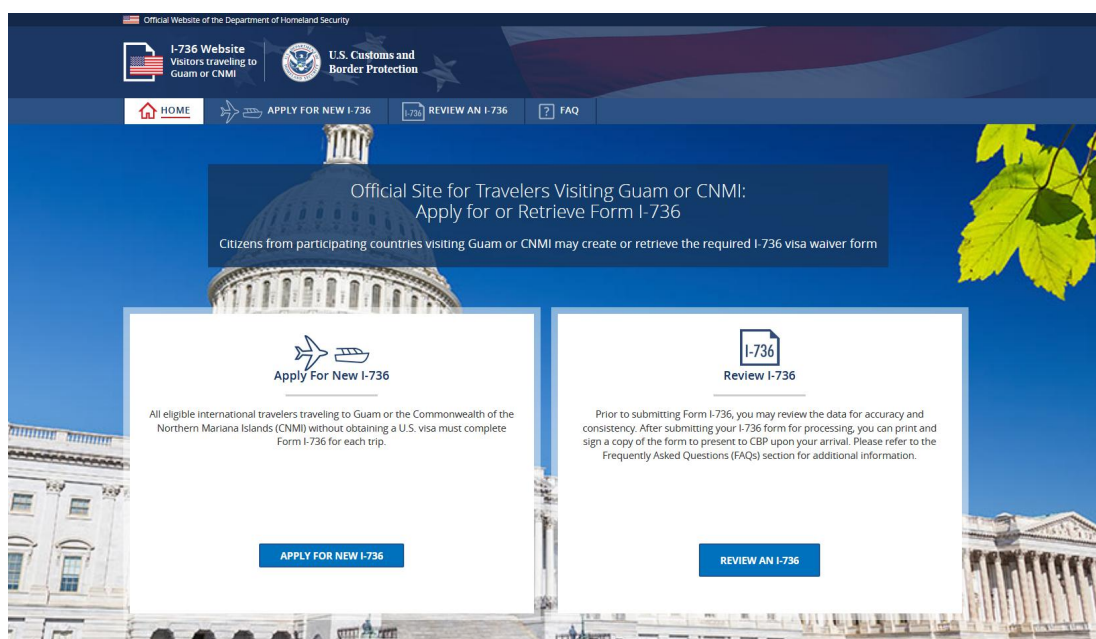

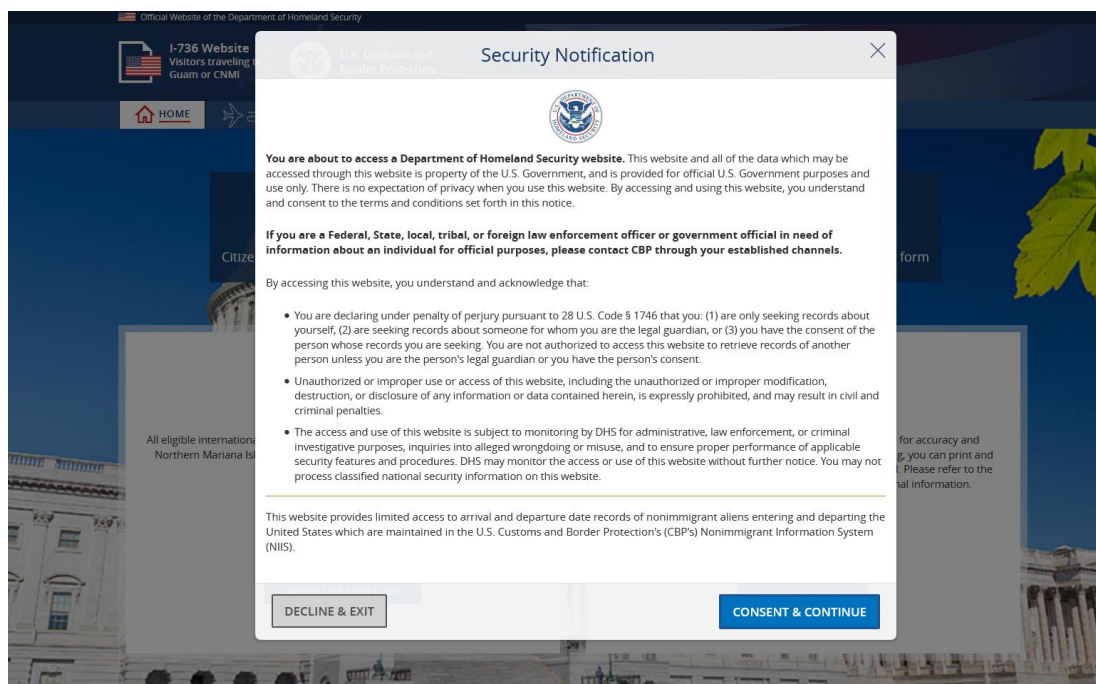

Before completing Form I-736, you must become familiar with the following requirements:

1. Be a national of a country or geographic area listed in 8 CFR 212.1(q);
2. Be classifiable as a visitor for business or pleasure;
3. Be solely entering and staying on Guam or the CNMI for a period not to exceed 45 days;
4. Be in possession of a round trip ticket that is nonrefundable and nontransferable and bears a confirmed departure date not exceeding 45 days from the date of admission to Guam or the CNMI;
5. Be in possession of a completed signed Guam-CNMI Visa Waiver information form (CBP Form I-736);
6. Be in possession of a completed I-94, Arrival-Departure Record (CBP Form I-94);
7. Be in possession of a valid unexpired ICAO compliant, machine readable passport issued by a country that meets the eligibility requirements of this section.

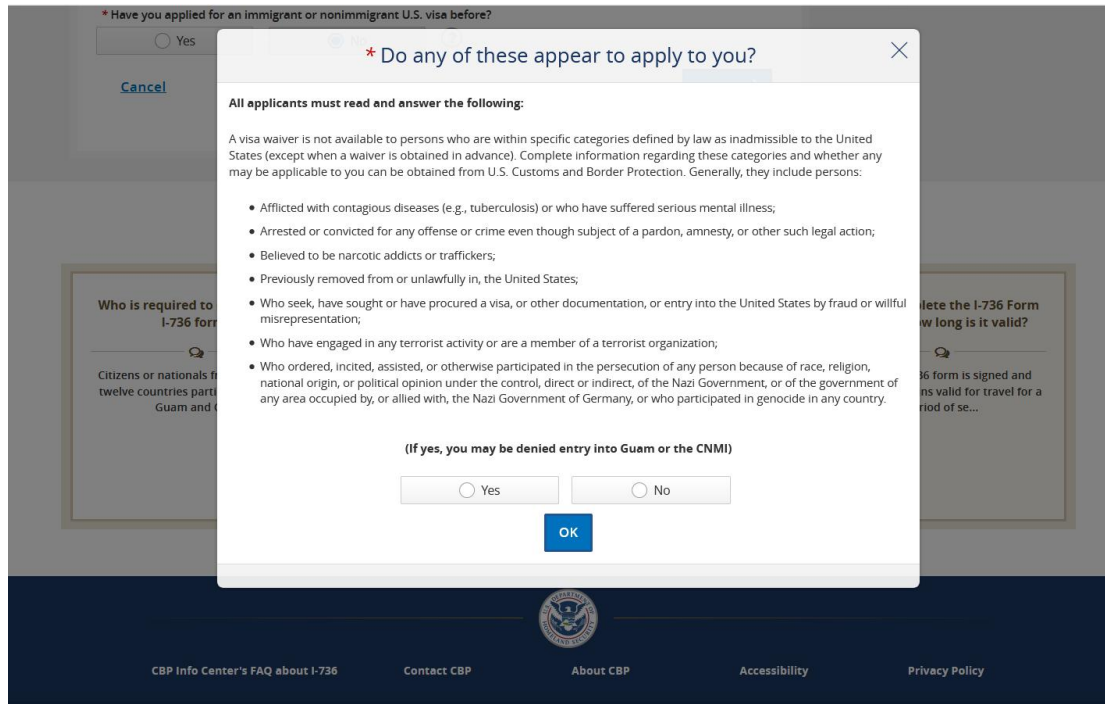

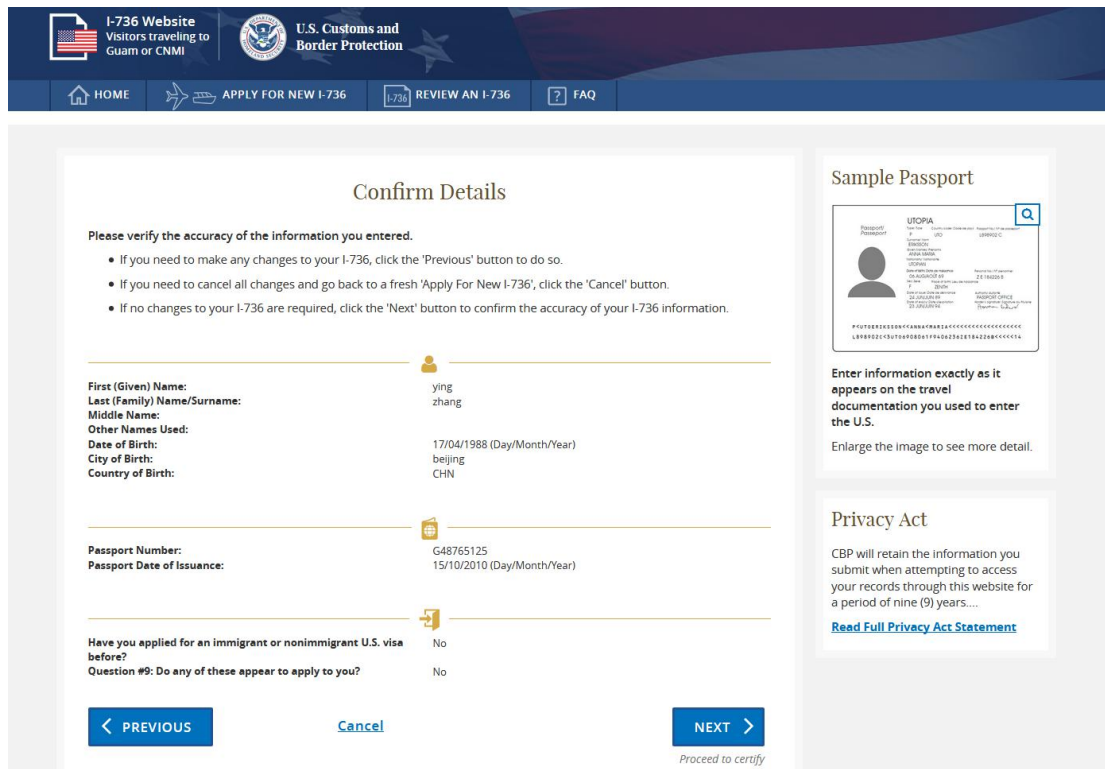
