

## CHILDREN AND MINOR TRAVELLING TO UAE

### 前往中东地区的儿童乘客及 18 岁以下的乘客

The United Arab Emirates (UAE) government has recently issued a new regulatory requirement on all minors (children under 18 years old) travelling to UAE that took effect on 01 June 2018.

All children and minors aged below 18 years old shall fulfill the following to be permitted entry to the United Arab Emirates:

**If travelling with a parent / guardian with a different surname**,如果 surname 与随行的父母或监护人不一样

- They shall have the document available to prove their relationship, e.g. copy of birth certificate indicating the parents' names or a similar document including the guardian's name

**If travelling with other adults (18 years old or above)**,如果与 18 岁及 18 岁以上的乘客同行,

- An authorization letter signed by the parents or guardian is required. 需要提供父母或监护人签名的委托信
- A copy of the document proving the relationship of the minor and the parents / guardian / whose name/s appear on the authorization letter should be attached. The authorization letter needs to include the following details:证明委托信上提及的父母或监护人与乘客的关系的文件

- a) Name of passenger and his/her flight details
- b) Contact number and address of the passengers in the UAE
- c) Name of parents / guardian and their signature/s
- d) Contact number and address of parents / guardian at the originating country

NOTE: Any person unable to fulfill the above requirements will be refused entry. 如果以上文件无法提供, 乘客可能会被拒绝登机。
