

## 关于进一步明确海航留学生客票操作办法的业务通告

### 一、定义：

**二、适用航线：**具有留学生优惠权益政策的海航国际及地区自营航线、海航实际运营的包机航线。

**三、适用航程：**单程、来回程、缺口程。

**四、适用地点：**各销售单位。

### 五、出票规定：

1.仅适用于 880 票证。

2.出票时需在旅客姓名后填写/SD（适用留学生）或/ASD（适用于留学生家属）。Q 票价时，均使用 QTE:SD/HU 指令，以确保享受留学生权益，适用于外航 ADDON 段及 SPA 段的行李额以系统显示为准。

3.出票时，各出票单位需同时检验留学生有效护照、与目的地相符的有效签证及相关证件（学生证或入学通知书等），并提醒旅客，乘机时务必携带相关证件，否则无法享受留学生权益，证件信息可参考附件一。

4.如姓名后无“SD/ASD”标识，则无法享受留学生权益（如免费行李额政策），由此产生的费用及投诉将由出票单位自行承担。

5.如发现违规出票，冒用留学生身份等情况，将对出票单位超出普通客票权益的差额部分实施 10 倍金额处罚。
