In accordance of IATA RESO 830d policy, SSR CTCM/CTCE/CTCR data input to PNR and require agent to actively ask the customer to provide their contact details for the purposes of contacts in an operational disruption. Please disseminate the handling regarding mandatory input of SSR CTCM/CTCE/CTCR on issuing ticket to all whom concerned.

■Input SSR code "CTCM/CTCE/CTCR"

CTCM...Mobile phone (phone number available during travel)

CTCE...E-mail address (E-mail address available during travel)

CTCR...Refused (Please input only when customer refused to provide their contact information)
