

# Test Requirements and Facilities for Passengers Bound for China Mainland via Frankfurt

## Journey starts from Germany

- 1 Within 48 hours before departure of the long-haul flight bound for China Mainland, passengers are required to obtain two Covid-19 tests at the origin city or at the dedicated test facilities at Frankfurt Airport:
- 2
  - Nucleic Acid Test (PCR) and
  - IgM Antibody Test.

The negative test certificates need to be validated by the Chinese Embassy in Germany to receive a

- Green HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or
- Green HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens).

► Designated test facilities at Frankfurt Airport  
PCR test at Centogene Squire next to Train Station  
IgM antibody test at Medical Center at Arrivals

## Journey starts from a Schengen country

- 1 Within 48 hours before boarding a flight from a Schengen or Non-Schengen country to Germany, passengers are required to obtain two Covid-19 tests at the origin city:
  - Nucleic Acid Test (PCR) and
  - IgM Antibody Test.

The negative test certificates need to be validated by the Chinese Embassy in the originating country to receive a

  - Green HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or
  - Green HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens).

- 2 Upon arrival at Frankfurt Airport, passengers are required to obtain two Covid-19 tests (PCR and an IgM antibody) again. The negative test certificates need to be validated by the Chinese Embassy in Germany to receive a
  - Green HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or
  - Green HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens).

► Designated test facilities at Frankfurt Airport  
PCR test at Centogene Squire next to Train Station  
IgM antibody test at Medical Center at Arrivals

## Journey starts from a Non-Schengen country

► Designated test facilities at Frankfurt Airport  
PCR and IgM antibody tests at Non-Schengen Transit Area near Gate Z 12 (beyond security control)

- 3 At the day of departure of the long-haul flight bound for China Mainland, passengers are required to fill the Customs Entry/Exit Declaration to obtain a
  - Red Customs Entry/Exit Health Code.

Keep a screenshot of the code. This code has a validity of 24 hours.

- 4 Passengers are required to present two codes to board the aircraft bound for China Mainland:
  - Green HS Code (Chinese Citizens) + Red Customs Entry/Exit Health Code or
  - Green HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens) + Red Customs Entry/Exit Health Code.

- 5 Passengers are required to present one code to deboard the aircraft after landing in China Mainland:
  - Red Customs Entry/Exit Health Code.

# The Requirements for Passengers travel from China Mainland on Lufthansa

## Journey starts from China Mainland

- Passengers need to obtain and present at the airport a Red Customs Entry/Exit Health Code before boarding.
- To board the long-haul flight in China Mainland to Germany, no Covid-19 test is required.

## Arrival at Frankfurt and beyond

- Countries (transit or final destination) may ask for a proof of negative Covid-19 test after arrival.
- Please check the Department of Interior and Department of Health of your transit country and the country of your final destination.
