- Green HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or
- Green HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens).
- Upon arrival at Frankfurt Airport, passengers are required to obtain two Covid-19 tests (PCR and an IgM antibody) again.
 The negative test certificates need to be validated by the Chinese Embassy in Germany to receive a
 - Green HS Code (Chinese Citizens) or
 - Green HDC Code (Non-Chinese Citizens).

The Requirements for Passengers travel from China Mainland on Lufthansa

Journey starts from China Mainland

- Passengers need to obtain and present at the airport a Red Customs Entry/Exit Health Code before boarding.
- To board the long-haul flight in China Mainland to Germany, no Covid-19 test is required.

Arrival at Frankfurt and beyond

- Countries (transit or final destination) may ask for a proof of negative Covid-19 test after arrival.
- Please check the Department of Interior and Department of Health of your transit country and the country of your final destination.
