ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO TURKEY

The Turkish authorities have introduced requirements for customers arriving or transiting Turkey.

Please note that entry restrictions may be subject to change on short notice. You are responsible for ensuring that you are allowed entry into the country they are travelling from, to or are in transit through.

The following entry requirements apply:

Effective 29 December 2020 – 1 March 2021

- You must hold an original medical certificate of a negative coronavirus RT-PCR test result in English issued earliest 72 hours before departure.
- If you arrive in the country without a coronavirus RT-PCR test certificate, you are:
 - required to stay 7 nights in quarantine at a hotel or your residence after arriving in Turkey or alternatively at a designated place assigned by the

- authorities. The quarantine stay will be at your own expense.
- required to take a coronavirus RT-PCR test 7 days after your arrival. If the test result is negative, you are no longer required to stay in quarantine
- You are also required to hold a test certificate in case of transiting through Turkey to any third country.
- The PCR-test requirement does not apply to children below 6 years of age.
- All customers must complete a passenger locator form prior to arrival. The form is distributed by the cabin crew during the flight.
