

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO RUSSIA

The Russian authorities have introduced requirements for customers arriving in the country.

Please note that entry restrictions may be subject to change on short notice. You are responsible for ensuring that you are allowed entry into the country you are travelling from, to or are in transit through.

Nationals of Russia and holders of valid residence permits issued by Russia are eligible to enter the country, but there are restrictions in place for foreign travellers arriving in Russia.

Kindly contact the nearest Russian Embassy to find out if you are eligible to travel to Russia

- E-visa issuance is currently suspended, you will therefore need to obtain a normal sticker type visa from a Russian Consulate, if you are not eligible to enter the country without a visa

The following entry requirements apply for entry eligible travellers:

- You are required to have a negative coronavirus PCR-test result, taken within 72 hours prior to departure.
- The certificate must be written in English or Russian.
- You are required to have this certificate also in case of transiting via Russia.

The coronavirus test requirement does not apply to you if you are a Russian national.
