Reminder: Know the Entry Requirements Before Travel

To limit the spread of COVID-19, governments across the globe have imposed various travel restrictions. These new travel restrictions may be imposed or amended with little warning. Beginning July 6, 2021, fully vaccinated travellers arriving to Canada who meet specific conditions are exempt from the 14-day quarantine requirement, including the stay and COVID-19 test day-8. Before your customer flies with us to Canada, unless fully vaccinated or otherwise exempt, your customer must book and pay for a three-night stay in a government-authorized accommodation where they will remain until receiving the results from their first test. The list of government-authorized accommodations can be found on the Government of Canada website and Travel.gc.ca/travel-covid.

Each country/province also has unique requirements which may include forms that must be completed and submitted online, and/or printed and presented at the airport prior to boarding a flight. Failure to meet these requirements may result in long delays at the airport or upon arrival at the destination. Travellers may also be refused travel or be subject to government enforcement action for non-compliance.

In addition, the Hong Kong government has reduced mandatory hotel quarantine to 7 nights for fully vaccinated passengers from select countries, who are in possession of a positive antibody test and also tested negative in a nucleic acid test during 'test and hold' upon arrival in Hong Kong:
