Subject: Reservation Booking Class Changes of JAL Japan Domestic Flights in
International Through Fare

Please be informed that Japan Airlines will make changes to reservation booking class (Reservation Booking Designator-RBD) for JAL Group Japan domestic flights used in International Through Fare as follows.

1. Effective Date

Reservation and ticketing on/after 06 July 2021 (10:00 a.m. Japan Time).

※For tickets issued on/before 05 July 2021, the applicable booking class valid on the original ticketing date will be applied to the reissue.

2. Applicable flights

JAL Group Japan domestic flights (excluding JL*/GK code-share flights) which are used in International Through Fare departing on/after 01 July 2022.

3. Change of booking class

The applicable booking class for JAL Group Japan domestic flights for International Through Fare will be changed as shown in the following table. (Changes are in red font)

[Examples for Case 1]

If international sector cabin is “First”, “Business” and “Economy”

Japan domestic sector's RBD will be the same as International sector's RBD.

E.g.1) If the international sector is B class, the domestic sector is also booked in B class.

If Japan domestic sector doesn't provide same cabin service as international sector or unable to book the same RBD

as international due no seat is available

Highest RBD (J or Y class) in lower cabin will be used to book on Japan domestic sector.

E.g.2) International sectors are booked in C class and Japan domestic sector doesn't provide Business cabin service:

⇒Japan Domestic sectors' RBD will be Y class.

E.g.3) International sectors are booked in F class, Japan domestic sector doesn't provide First class service but have Business cabin service:

⇒Japan Domestic sectors' RBD will be J class.

4. Change of mileage accumulation rate

The mileage accumulation rate for JAL Group's Japan domestic sector (excluding JL*/GK code share flights) for International Through Fare will also be changed as follows.
