

# General testing obligation for entry into Switzerland

Starting 4 December 2021, *all travelers aged 16 and over must present a PCR test (issued within 72 hours before departure) in order to enter Switzerland.* Other tests, e.g. Antigen, will not be accepted anymore.

Furthermore, all persons must have completed the entry form with their contact details (Swiss PLF). This can be done [online](#) or on paper.

In addition, passengers entering Switzerland must be tested again between the fourth and seventh day after entry. All test results must be reported to the canton.

Transit passengers who travel to Switzerland with SWISS and have an international onward flight on the same day are exempt from the testing requirement. However, the entry form must still be completed in this case.
