Latest update on Hong Kong Flight Schedules

This bulletin supersedes a previous bulletin Ref. 2213 on Feb22, 2022.

As a result of the extended flight ban from Canada by the Hong Kong Government, Air Canada has revised its flight schedules in March and April.

Flights AC007 from Vancouver to Hong Kong have been cancelled until April 22, 2022. This flight will resume on 23 April and will operate on the following dates:

Flights AC008 from Hong Kong to Vancouver will continue to operate in March and April on the following dates :

* Passengers can remain in their seats on board during the technical stop at Seoul Incheon airport. There is no need to deplane, and there will not be any passengers joining the flight at Incheon.

Please refer to your GDS for the latest flight schedule and consult the latest Schedule Change Policy (Ref: 2202) for your options to rebook, refund, or convert the ticket to Air Canada Travel Voucher.

Please be reminded that segment status changes due to a Schedule Change (SKCH) will be queued to your CRS and must be actioned within 14 days from the schedule change notification or 7 days prior to departure, whichever is earlier. This includes cancelling ticketed or un-ticketed segments with TK status code. If Air Canada determines that a CRS subscriber has engaged in practices that conflict with these procedures, the travel agency will be subject to \$50 CAD/USD charge per passenger for each TK segment (SKCH) not actioned within the time frame.
