Update: Hong Kong International Airport Transit Requirement

Passengers travelling on airlines that can connect with Air Canada in Hong Kong will be able to transit through Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA) if comply with the following requirements.

- Connecting flights are booked **under the same booking or same air ticket**.
- It is passenger's responsibility to ascertain their eligibility to enter the destination country.
- Passengers baggage must be checked through to the final destination at the first airport of the itinerary.
- Passengers must be issued with boarding passes (printed onward or mobile onward boarding pass) of both connecting flights into and out of Hong Kong at the origin airport. Failure to do so may lead to denied boarding at the origin airport, or deported back to the origin after landing at Hong Kong International Airport.
- Maximum layover time inside Hong Kong International Airport is 24 hours.
- Negative result proof of a PCR-based nucleic acid test for COVID-19 within 48 hours of the direct flight to Hong Kong (including documentary proofs that the lab is ISO15189 accredited or Government recognised).
- Passengers starting their trip in the Chinese Mainland are able to transit Hong Kong International Airport, however, transit to destination in Mainland China remains unavailable at HKIA.
