Update: Hong Kong International Airport Transit Requirement

Effective immediately, passengers can use Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA) for transit/transfer on flights operated by different airlines.

Passengers travelling on airlines that can connect with Air Canada in Hong Kong will be able to transit through Hong Kong International Airport if they comply with the following requirements:

- Passengers hold a confirmed ticket or onward boarding pass (printed onward or mobile onward boarding pass) departing Hong Kong International Airport within 24 hours of their scheduled time of arrival. Failure to do so may lead to denied boarding at the origin airport, or deported back to the origin after landing at Hong Kong International Airport.
- Passengers' baggage must be tagged through to their onward destination.
- It is passenger's responsibility to ascertain their eligibility to enter the destination country.
- Passengers starting their trip in the Chinese Mainland are able to transit Hong Kong International Airport, however, transit to destinations in Mainland China remains unavailable at Hong Kong International Airport.
