Update: Baggage Through-Check on Separate Tickets

Baggage through-check on separate tickets has resulted in unnecessary liability and system issues for Air Canada, as well as a violation of IATA requirements on separate bookings.

Air Canada has decided to follow suit with our partners and no longer offer throughchecking of baggage when booked on separate tickets as per IATA recommendations.

As a result, **when two separate tickets are involved**, Air Canada will no longer through-check customer and/or baggage to the destinations of the second ticket, **except for** the below scenarios:

- 1. Separate Air Canada (014) tickets
- 2. Separate tickets with Pacific Costal (8P) or Air North (4N)
- 3. An exception approved by Regulatory or Legal and documented on customer's file
- 4. Two tickets due to single coupon reissue during irregular operations (including AC to OAL)

Example: Customer has an original ticket YUL-**AC**-YYZ-**LH**-FRA, now reissued due to IROP on two tickets YUL-AC-YYZ on AC (014) ticket and YYZ-LH-FRA single coupon reissued on LH (220) ticket.

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
