

AEROMEXICO TO RECONNECT TOKYO WITH MEXICO CITY

- The route will restart on March 25, 2023 with a daily flight.
- It will allow the exchange of tourists, business travel and freight, taking advantage of the airline's network within Mexico, Central and South America, as well as the Caribbean.

Mexico City, November 7, 2022.- Aeromexico reinforces its ongoing commitment to connect Mexico with the world. Starting March 25, the airline will restart nonstop service from Tokyo to Mexico City.

After nearly three years, the airline will once again add Asia to its global network of destinations, more conveniently connected to other points on the continent, with Aeromexico's network of more than 40 destinations within Mexico, as well as eight in Central America-Caribbean and seven in South America, making this route highly beneficial not only for tourism, but also for business development and cargo transportation.

Aeromexico flew to Japan from 2006 to 2020; and resuming operations in Tokyo is very relevant because it means connecting directly and nonstop the Asian continent with the company's country of origin, flying with the Boeing 787 Dreamliner, the safest, most modern, efficient and environmentally friendly aircraft that exists.

Mexico is one of the five most important countries in the world tourism sector, receiving almost 32 million visitors last year. The country is renowned for its beaches, colonial cities, gastronomy and cultural wealth.

The start of direct operations between Tokyo and Mexico is a reflection of Aeromexico's commitment to offer the best air connectivity network, which by March 2023 will exceed 100 domestic and international routes, operating under the highest safety and service standards in the industry.

Aeromexico thanks the authorities of Mexico and Japan for their support and willingness to make this route a reality, which will further promote partnerships between the two countries.
